
Please note that the power pack is delivered without hydraulic oil. Therefore it must be filled with hydraulic oil prior to operation.

IMPORTANT: Read and follow this operating manual carefully to avoid personal injury and damage to the power pack.

Safety Precautions

- 1. Always use ear protection, though power pack has a low noise level.
- 2. Always connect hoses before starting.
- 3. Always keep electric box, cables and sockets clean.
- 4. Always turn of the motor and disconnect the power supply when the power pack not used and before performing any service.
- 5. Never start the motor without side covers and the safety guard.
- 6. Operation of the power pack without tool connected and with lever at "ON" may cause overheating of the system and damage to the power pack.
- 7. It is recommended to use a crane when lifting the power pack.
- 8. The pressure relief valve is set at 160 bar / 2320 psi from the HYCON plant. Never set it higher.
- 9. Always use original HYCON filters with by-pass. The use of filters without by-pass may blow the hydraulic hoses and the filter cover.

Filling of Hydraulic Oil

- To fill up with hydraulic oil, loosen the filter cover on top of the power pack.
- Remove the filter element (see photo), and fill up with oil. When oil is showing at the bottom of the filter unit, there is enough oil on the power pack.
- Insert the filter element again, mount the cover and the power pack is ready for use.





IMPORTANT: When connecting new extension hoses, it is necessary to fill up with extra 2 liters / 0.53 gallons of oil. Therefore always top up the power pack when connecting new extension hoses.

Technical data

The HYCON HPP18E FLEX open center power pack is an advanced hydraulic power source, which regulates the revolutions of the motor and thereby the oil flow supplied by means of a built in frequency converter.

The power pack covers four different flow outputs of 20, 30, 40 and 46 LPM / 5, 8, 10 and 12 GPM respectively at 120 bar / 1740 psi. This HYCON power pack is fully compatible with and sufficient for the common European and North American tools.

A pressure relief valve are used to avoid a too high pressure of the power pack. The very efficient air cooling protects the power pack against overheating.




Important: Power packs with 46 LPM / 12 GPM option are not CE approved.

Starting Instructions

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WARNING: Before start up, ensure all conditions under Safety precautions are full filled.

Please observe the starting instructions on the frequency converter box.

• Check hydraulic oil level at sight glass

Connect hoses and tool

• Turn the "0 / 1" cam switch to "1"

Move the lever to "ON"

Stop: • Move the lever to "OFF"

Turn the "0 / 1" cam switch to "0"

Oil Flow

Always set the oil flow correctly in accordance with the tool connected. Choose the oil flow on the four step cam switch:

1: 20 LPM / 5 GPM

2: 30 LPM / 8 GPM

3: 40 LPM / 10 GPM

4: 46 LPM / 12 GPM (N/A for CE approved power packs)

Hydraulic Settings

Check the working pressure by means of test equipment. The test equipment must comprise a pressure gauge, a flow meter and a valve for adjustment of pressure.

The pressure relief valve is placed on the valve block on the right side.

Connect the test equipment, start the power pack and move the lever to "ON". Then
close the valve on the test equipment - the pressure gauge must show 160 bar / 2320
psi.

Adjust the pressure relief valve by loosening the lock nut and turning the adjustment screw in or out. "In" increases the pressure, and "out" decreases the pressure. Retighten the lock nut after adjustment.

2. When the pressure relief valve has been adjusted correctly, the working pressure must be set at 100 bar / 1450 psi by means of the valve on the test equipment. At 100 bar / 1450 psi check that the oil flow is correct according to the technical data.



IMPORTANT: If correct pressure/oil flow cannot be achieved by following the instructions above, the power pack must be re-adjusted. Is the pressure/oil flow then still incorrect, the pump might be defect and a replacement is necessary.

Oil Types

The HYCON power packs use standard hydraulic oil, i.e. all types of mineral oil and biodegradable oil, which comply with the following values:
